- ii. Theme Week - Role of Peace Research
  - 1. Meeting with Ale/ Movie Screening
    - a. Anicca met with Ale to discuss ideas for the theme week, main take-aways:
      - i. Ale suggested a documentary about the role of football/ sports in achieving community reconciliation and peacebuilding in Colombia
      - ii. Afterwards we may have a discussion/ Q&A about the role of art and journalism in conveying conflict realities and inspiring change with the filmmaker Jesus Abad Colorado, a Colombian photographer and journalist, best known for his work documenting the armed conflict and human rights issues in Colombia
      - iii. Ale will reach out and inquire whether he is available, and whether we could have access to the movie
  - 2. The Intersection of Activism and Academia (panel discussion)
    - a. Marta and Uma are meeting with Simone tomorrow
    - b. Isak already agreed to participate
    - c. Irene...?
    - d. We are still waiting on the response of the PhD students regarding potential moderation
  - 3. The Role of Universities in Conflict Research
    - a. Linus reached out regarding the Russia expert, we are waiting for a response

  - 4. Research and Journalism in Conflict Zones (Workshop)
    - a. Marta is reaching out to Reporters without Borders and inquire whether anyone could host a workshop
